The only information required is - your name, address and signature indicating that you pay tax. You will be given a set of envelopes – one for each Sunday of the year. There is no obligation to donate the same amount each week or even to donate at all each week. You may join or leave the scheme at any time. Alternatively, you may wish to contribute by standing order.
