Announcement: As you are aware that the Government has announced new measures banning social gatherings of more than 6 people in a range of settings. It has been confirmed that this new measure does not apply to places of worship.

Roof Work at St. Boniface, Okehampton: The works are due to commence on Thursday 17th September. As communicated earlier (please refer 2nd August bulletin for more details) the cost has gone up to £50,000. The Diocese has approved this. On the top of the special collections and fundraising events there have been significant donations from some of our Parishioners in the recent past towards the roof fund. Thanks to you all. The total amount we have collected towards the roof fund up until this day is £18,302.30 plus the legacy amount £25,000. Due to the recent expense on the Chagford roof (paid out £9,223.08), we are short of £15,920.78. Any donation towards this would be gratefully received.

1st September is World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation and marks the start of the Season of Creation – an opportunity for us all to reflect on how we care for our Common Home. The Season runs until 4 October – the Feast Day of St Francis of Assisi. In his message for Laudato Si' week, Bishop Mark said 'Our earth is the home for the human family. We invite everyone to reflect, to pray, and to act, so that we achieve that ecological conversion that the Holy Father calls us to. Churches are open on Sundays for Mass: Both of our churches are open now for Masses on Sundays. Thanks to all the volunteers for the willingness, dedication, and hard work. We have been considering various options regarding managing the attendance. The consensus is to follow first come first serve approach. Therefore, the encouragement for people who wish to attend is to arrive at least 15 minutes early for the services. Those who wish to attend Mass in the Church, please follow the social distancing. The capacity of the church will be reduced to between 17 and 24 people, depending on how many attend from the same household. Please be understanding that the number limit must be adhered to which means you may not be able to stay for Mass if the capacity has been reached. Entrance by the main front door only, exit by the back door only (this is different for Chagford). Please wear a mask or face covering, and keep this on throughout the service, except when receiving communion. People who attend the Mass are encouraged to bring their own small bottle of hand sanitiser to use before the communion.
